

The Church has an awkward relationship with the secular world of management and the language of competency and strategy. As Christian ministry seeks to share in God's Mission, churches and their leaders are often shy of engaging with the language and the concepts of professional organisation and management.

The Susanna Wesley Foundation for Ministry, Management & Organisation aims to encourage the exchange of ideas between those involved in ministerial education, business academics, educationalists, management development specialists, clergy of all denominations, and theologians, asking the question: 'what have Church institutions to learn from current approaches to management, and what have these approaches to learn from our churches?' These are also the themes for the Foundation's inaugural day conference, **Ministry & management: God & mammon?**

The conference will feature keynote addresses and several sessions for short papers (20 minutes) by delegates. We would welcome proposals for papers which are still in development that have relevance to the themes of the Conference, and invite those who are interested to send abstracts of between 250 and 500 words to the Foundation's Research Coordinator, Sue Miller, by 22 June 2014.

We are also planning to provide an opportunity for a poster session. Please indicate your intention to bring a poster by emailing with information about the topic and your proposed format.
