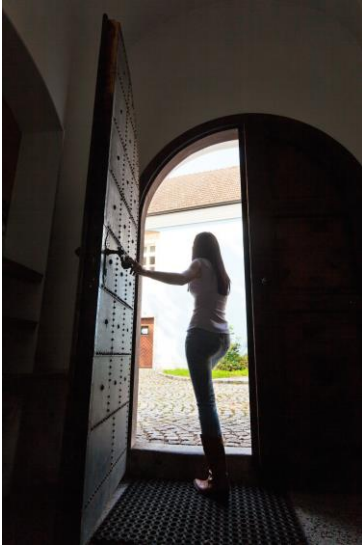


Catherine of Siena College —

Women, Leadership and Ministry: Short Course

1st March - 23rd April 2017



This course examines the role of women in Christian leadership with a particular focus on recent developments in church life. Drawing from a variety of Wesleyan and other Christian sources, students will engage with texts, contexts and practices from their own denominational heritage and examine them comparatively with those of other traditions. The course will provide an opportunity to study leadership theories and feminist theologies to help identify the concepts of power and influence that operate in particular cultural and ecclesial contexts. Throughout the course, students will be encouraged to reflect on their own denominational context and experience and practice of ministry, interrogating their assumptions and perspectives, and to integrate their learning into their future approaches to leadership.

Catherine of Siena College offers a personal approach to online learning, providing lots of opportunities for live conversation and discussion with other students and the tutor, and staff contacts available to ask any questions or concerns throughout and after the course.
